- He hid under an umbrella and called himself a mushroom.

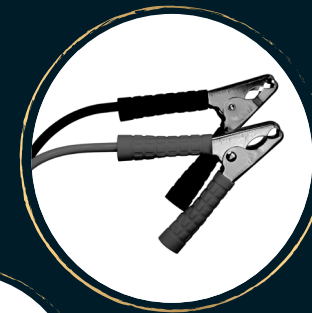
ACTIVITY:
